When: November



Select a 4-H theme for your poster. THINK of a clever way to emphasize 4-H. You may show what you think 4-H is, activities in 4-H, benefits of 4-H, or anything about 4-H.

- # Illustrate your theme with drawings, magazine cut-outs, or any other art media. Anything glued to poster may not stick out more than 1/8 inch.
- * Poster size is 14 "X 22" and must be horizontal (one-half sheet of poster board, example: 2 posters shown above).
- **Well-known cartoon characters cannot** be used.
- * Write your name, age, school, grade, teacher and home address on the back of the poster.
- Poster must be made by the 4-H member.

AWARDS: Blue, Red or White awards to be presented for each poster at local meeting.
