



Steps to a Good Demonstration:



Step I.

Select a topic: look in your 4-H project book for ideas. Chose something that interests you. *Demonstration length - 2 to 3 minutes.*

Example: Wildlife - How to make a birdfeeder
Arts & Crafts - Making an ink blot
Photography - Doing trick Photography



Step II.

- Outline key points. Include information needed for you audience to understand.
- Plan an interesting beginning for your presentation that will get everyone's attention.
- Posters can be helpful to illustrate key information.

Summary:

End your demonstration with a summary of the most important points of your presentation.

- When you have finished, remove all your materials and leave the work area clean.
